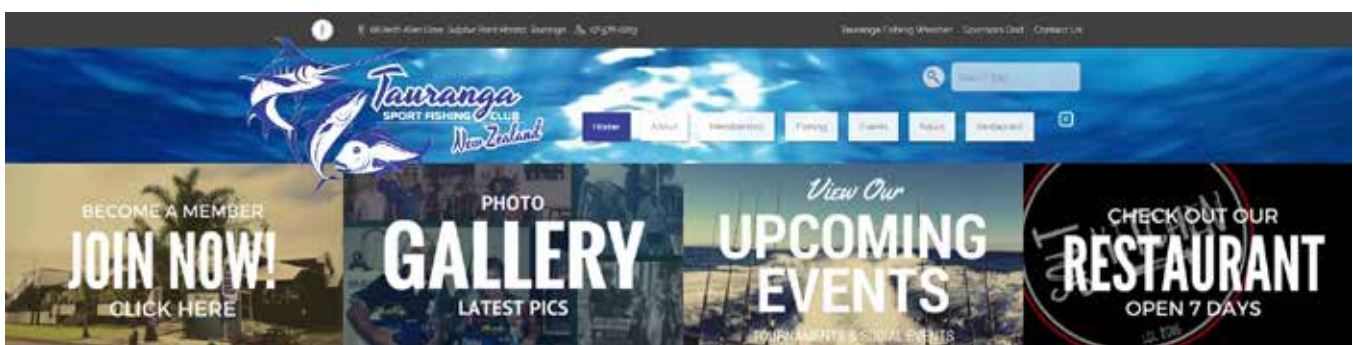

Wreckfish (including Bass, Hapuku & Bluenose) - min weight 10kg. Kingfish - min length 1m. Snapper - min weight 2kg. Tarakihi, Gurnard & Trevally - min length 25cm. Kahawai & John Dory.

ANGLER PRIZES:

Prizes for 1st, 2nd & 3rd heaviest of each species. Junior prize and Best Hard Luck Story, Lucky draws & Spot prizes at Briefing & Prize Giving.

In the event of fish not being caught in one category, then prizes will be drawn.

(Fish Limit - Restricted to two fish per species, per angler per day and must be weighed each day)

ELIGIBILITY	Open to all Club Members & Members of NZSFC affiliated clubs.
LINE WEIGHT	Fish must be caught in accordance with Club tournament & IGFA rules
ENTRY FEE	25.00 per Adult and Junior anglers.
DAY MEMBERSHIP	Adult: \$20.00 Junior: \$1.00 (Covers both days)
Entries will be accepted by phone or via the club website with credit card details (TSFC members only). Full refunds will be given for any reason provided a refund is requested before briefing. Team entries must be in by 6.00pm on briefing night.

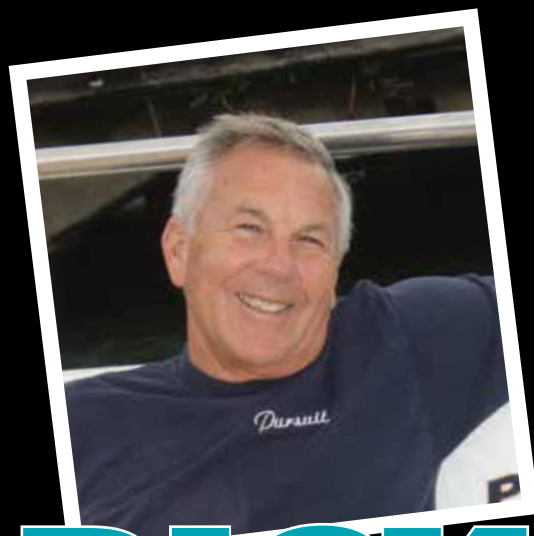
complement any other fishing you are doing, so get into it!

OCTOBER -John Dory (1.5kg) - **NOVEMBER** -Snapper (2.5kg) - **DECEMBER** -Kingfish (1m)

- Entry Fee:** \$20.00 (Includes Adults & Juniors)
Entry: Entry fee covers the weigh-in of each of the six named species and must be paid no later than the day prior to weigh-in of your first fish. Anglers may only have one fish per ladder at any one time. Bigger fish may replace smaller fish (if caught)
Teams: Anglers may fish this tournament as individuals including fishing from PWCs and kayaks as long as they have communications with Coastguard or a support vessel.
Fishing Area: Fish must be caught within NZ Chart 54 (mod) and must be weighed in at the TSFC. Random access permitted (boats may launch from anywhere)
Rules: Fish must be fresh and caught in accordance with Club, NZSFC and IGFA rules.
Points: Accumulating ladder total. Highest position 10 points descending. Any species can be weighed any month to contribute to anglers final points.
Prizes: Sweepstake and Ian Milburn Trophy, Adults 1st – 3rd. Monthly Bar (\$50) and Salt Kitchen voucher (\$50) for largest nominated species for the month. Should a junior angler win, \$50 Salt Kitchen voucher will replace bar voucher. Sweepstakes paid 70%, 20% and \$10% respectively for 1st-3rd point leaders (across all species)
Final Weight In: 6.00pm Thursday 31 December 2016.

MPI - time to cut the chain?

John Key and Minister Nathan Guy must be starting to wonder when is the best time to cut their losses and jettison fisheries matters into a new ministry, as far from the Primary Industries mothership as possible.

Because just when things are starting to look a little sunny in dairy prices, a big greenie full of more bad fisheries news rolls over the deck and sweeps everything in its path.

Meanwhile, MPI remain silent and no meaningful changes have been announced.

Here at FryUp HQ the team has been busy keeping an eye on all things fish.

Will this end in tears?

The fallout continues over the lack of any Ministry prosecutions against commercial fishers caught dumping quota fish. Now, even the New Zealand Listener has published a stinging attack on the Quota Management System and fisheries management.

The Ed pulls no punches in saying, "a system supposedly devised to ensure the sustainability of our fisheries may be having the opposite effect".

And goes on to say, "What's equally scandalous is that the conspiracy of silence around dumping would probably have continued had the practice not been exposed by a University of Auckland study that concluded that the total fisheries catch since 1986 was far higher than officially reported. That was followed by the leaking of internal reports that confirmed the ministry had clear evidence of fish dumping but had decided not to prosecute".

This "conspiracy of silence" is a concern for all of us, as once again it portrays a ministry in partnership with an industry exploiting a public resource, instead of working for the public. The more sunlight that is being shone onto this murky affair, the more dirt we see. Shudder to think what will be revealed next week.

LegaSea is maintaining the call for a comprehensive, independent review of the Quota Management System and how our fisheries are managed. Only a Commission of Inquiry can delve deep enough into the trough to reach the truth. Please add your voice to this call by voting in the poll.

Green Lipped Mussels & Chorizo

Ingredients

- 1kg Mussels
- 100g Chorizo sausage
- 1 Charred Capsicum
- 1 Tomato
- 3 Crushed garlic cloves
- 1 Cup White wine
- 2 Tbsp Parsley
- 2 Tbsp Chopped chives

Method:

Clean and remove beard from fresh mussels, discard cracked mussels. Slice chorizo thinly. Dice tomato and chargrilled capsicum. Cook mussels and chorizo with garlic, capsicum and tomato in a large pot with a tight fitting lid in the wine until mussels open. Add chopped herbs and serve with plenty of bread to soak up the juices.
