Open to all Club Members & Members of NZSFC affiliated clubs. **ELIGIBILITY LINE WEIGHT** Fish must be caught in accordance with Club tournament & IGFA rules **ENTRY FEE** Adult: \$40.00 Junior: \$10.00 DAY MEMBERSHIP Adult: \$20.00 (covers both days) Junior: \$1.00 (covers both days)

Entries will be accepted by phone or via the Club. Full refunds will be given for any reason provided a refund is requested before briefing. Entries not paid by 6.00pm on briefing night will not be eligible for lucky draws on briefing night. No entries will be accepted between 6pm on briefing night and the end of briefing. Anglers may be added to teams up until 9.00pm Friday 8 September 2017.

Anglers may fish this tournament as individuals including fishing from PWCs and kayaks **TEAMS**

as long as they have VHF communications with COASTGUARD

BRIEFING 6.30pm Friday 8 September 2017. Briefing is compulsory.

register at the office on briefing night, no later than 6.30pm and is to attend and remain until the conclusion of briefing unless prior approval to not attend has been given by the

Tournament Convenor.

Final weigh in time shall be the end of the contest. All fish and catch cards must be in the possession of the weigh station staff by the final weigh in time. (No exceptions). In the event of fish not being caught in one category, then prizes will be drawn.
