Briefing is compulsory & team captains or a nominated team member who is fishing the tournament must register at the office on briefing night, no later than 6.30pm and is to attend and remain until the conclusion of briefing unless prior approval to not attend has been given by the Tournament Convenor.

Final weigh-in time shall be the end of the contest. All fish and catch cards must be at the weigh station by the final weigh-in time (no exceptions)

CALCUTTA AUCTION @ Briefing STARTS AT 6.30PM THURSDAY 18th JANUARY

EEWW ARGG..HERE ARE THE RULES ME HEARTIES!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

Calcutta Definition – “Is a form of betting in tournaments, in which gamblers bid for participating contestants in an auction, the proceeds from which are put into a pool for distribution, according to a prearranged scale of percentages, to those who selected winners”

In the GAME ON Calcutta you may bid for the Team who you hope will win top TEAM. Top Team will be the team to accumulate the MOST BILLFISH POINTS (both for tag and released and weighed). The prize money will be divided as per the schedule below.

1ST – 65% 2nd – 15% 3rd – 10%

CLUB – 10%

*******Winnings will be paid out the night of prize giving.**

THE RULES.....

1. Only Captains (or nominated representatives) are eligible to bid.
2. At least one member of the team must be financially entered in the Tournament by 6pm Thursday 19th January. Cut off for Calcutta registration is also 6pm.
3. Every Team will be auctioned.
4. Should any Team be scratched no refunds will be given.
5. In the eventuality of any draw. The prize money will be split across placings. IE 65% +15% / 2
6. Payment must be made in full at the conclusion of the auction. (within 1 hour). Failure to do so will forfeit the bid and the boat scratched.
