LINE WEIGHT Fish must be caught in accordance with Club tournament & IGFA rules ENTRY FEE Adult: \$45.00 Early Bird before 31st August / \$55 from 1st September Junior: \$10.00 **DAY MEMBERSHIP** Adult: \$10.00 (per day) Junior: \$1.00 (per day) Entries will be accepted via the Club or website www.tsfc.co.nz. Full refunds will be given for any reason provided a refund is requested before briefing. Entries not paid by 6.00pm on briefing night will not be eligible for lucky draws on briefing night. No entries will be accepted between 6pm on briefing night and the end of briefing. Anglers may be added to teams anytime throughout the tournament, but must be entered in the event prior to capture of any fish. Anglers may fish from any vessel throught the duration of the tournamet and as may TEAMS fish as individuals including fishing from PWCs and kayaks as long as they have VHF communications with COASTGUARD BRIEFING 6.30pm Thursday 29 August 2019. Team captains or a nominated team member who is fishing the tournament must NOTE register at the office on briefing night, no later than 6.30pm and is to attend and remain until the conclusion of briefing unless prior approval to not attend has been given by the Tournament Convenor. PRIZE GIVING 6.30pm Thursday 3rd October 2019 Final weigh in time shall be the end of the contest. All fish and catch cards must be in the possession of the weigh station staff by the final weigh in time. (No exceptions). In the event of fish not being caught in one category, then prizes will be drawn.
