DAY MEMBERSHIP	Day membership is available Adults: \$20, Juniors \$5.00 (COVERS BOTH DAYS) All entries via TSFC with payment at the Club or via internet banking to 12-3209-0153933-00 Ref:Ladies . Full refunds will be given for any reason provided a refund is requested before briefing. Entries not paid by 5.30pm on briefing night will not be eligible for lucky draws on briefing night. No entries will be accepted between 6.00pm on briefing night and the end of briefing. No entries will be accepted after 9.00pm Thursday 6th February 2020.
TEAMS	Anglers may fish this tournament as individuals including fishing from PWCs and kayaks as long as they have VHF communications with Tournamnet comms through Game Base (Ch3) trip reports through COASTGUARD (Ch1).
BRIEFING	6:30pm Thursday 6th February 2020. Briefing is compulsory & team captains or a nominated team member who is fishing the tournament must register on briefing night, no later than 6.30pm and is to attend and remain until the conclusion of briefing unless prior approval to not attend has been given by the Tournament Convenor.
START FISHING WEIGH-IN	After briefing 4:00pm-5:00pm Fri 7th Feb 2020 & 3.00pm-5.00pm Sat 8th Feb 2020 Final weigh-in time shall be the end of the contest. All fish and catch cards must be at the weigh station and HERO SHOTS emailed through by the final weigh-in time (no exceptions)
PRIZE GIVING	6.30pm Saturday 8th February 2020 (including FANCY DRESS) Followed by LIVE ENTERTAINMENT 'Shabang'
