TEAMS Anglers may fish this tournament as individuals including fishing from PWCs and kayaks as long as they have VHF communications with COASTGUARD CH1

BRIEFING 6.30pm Thursday 16th January 2020

NOTE Briefing is compulsory and team captains or a nominated team member who is fishing the tournament must register at the office on briefing night, no later than 6.00pm and is to attend and remain until the conclusion of briefing unless prior approval to not attend has been given by the Tournament Convenor. All Anglers MUST collect "Angler Number Cards" from TSFC prior to fishing.

After briefing on Thursday 16th January 2020 START FISHING WEIGH IN 3.00pm - 5.00pm Friday 17th January 2020 3.00pm - 5.00pm Saturday 18th January 2020

Final weigh in time shall be the end of the contest. All fish, catch cards & photos must be at

the weigh station by the final weigh in time. (no exceptions).

The skipper of the boat is always responsible for ensuring the area, weather and sea conditions are satisfactory for safe use for the craft they are using.













