ELIGIBILITY - Anglers may fish this tournament as individuals. Each team member must be a current financial member of the Tauranga Sport Fishing Club (Inc.) or a club affiliated to the New Zealand Sport Fishing Council. You must be entered into the Daltons Snapper Classic, the Garmin Swordfish Challenge and the YRW Bluefin Bust Up to qualify for complimentary and automatic entry.

To qualify anglers do not need to catch fish from all 3 species. Winners are by way of points only.

In the event of a tie Champion Angler/Boat/Junior, first to catch or T&R or Measure all fish to count for points wins.

Anglers can fish multiple boats at their discretion.

Champion boat-Skipper must be entered in the tournament by entering the Snapper/Swordfish & Bluefin Tournaments, if the Skipper of the boat is playing the fish they are still deemed as the skipper & do not need another angler entered in the tournament on board. Skippers must be entered prior to any fish caught to count towards the Champion Boat.

MAJOR FISH PRIZES -

5 Major Angler prizes (anglers will get to choose from prizes 1st – 5th order)

Champion Angler

Champion Boat

Champion Junior

ANGLER POINTS STRUCTURE -

All prize winners based on a points structure for Snapper/ Swordfish/ Bluefin TunA, Largest fish caught/T&R (Points) overall as stipulated in each individual tournament guide.

SNAPPER – The combined length of each anglers 3 longest fish x 2 points per Centimeter of length (ie 60cm + 70cm + 80cm = 210cm total x 2 points per cm is 420points)

SWORDFISH – The heaviest fish per angler (1 fish total) 1 point per kilogram of fish weighed or 100 points T&R (ie 150kg fish =150 points or 100 points if T&R)

BLUEFIN TUNA - The heaviest fish per angler (1 fish total), 2 points per kilogram of fish weighed or 70 points T&R (ie 70KG fish = 140 points or 70 points if T&R)
